There are three colleges in the district: Contra Costa College (San Pablo), Los Medanos College (Pittsburgh) and Diablo Valley College (Pleasant Hill). The college has several notable programs including the Center for Science Excellence, that works to increase minority participation in the sciences; High-Performance Computing Center, a pioneering program that teaches the emerging science of computer clustering; and the CCC Speech and Debate Team, which is one of the top community college teams in the nation.
